Project Description: The Applicant proposes operating an iron & manganese treatment plant (located at Well 6) to treat water from Well 6, Well 7, and Well 8 as part of their public water system that serves the East Area Specific Plan development.

This is to advise that the State Water Resources Control Board (Responsible Agency) has approved the above-described Project on May 15, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the State Water Board's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
6. Findings were made by the State Water Board pursuant to the California Code of Regulations Section 15091.
