Project Title: Montclair Basin Improvement Project No. RW15003.03 (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SBR-60860-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino County): The project is located at 4800 Moreno Street, in the City of Montclair, within San Bernardino County, State of California. The project is located within San Antonio Creek, tributary to the Santa Ana River.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SBR-60860-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Inland Empire Utilities Agency.

The project is limited to construction of two new diversion structures along the concrete-lined San Antonio Creek Channel to divert flow into the existing adjacent Montclair Basins 2 and 3. The added diversions will span the full width of the 25-foot-wide concrete lined channel.


This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 5/12/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to Section 15096, subdivision (j) of the California Code of Regulations:

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
