Project Title: Post Mountain Road Sediment Reduction Project, Phase 1 (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TRI-62980-R1)

Project Location (Trinity County): Post Mountain, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-TRI-62980-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, Cannabis Conservation.

The project includes the replacement and armoring of 5 culverts on rural roads in Post Mountain, California. All culverts will be installed consistent with submitted engineering plans.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 02/25/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
