Caltrans received a notice of completion of the City of San Diego Addendum for the 4620 Pacific Highway (a.k.a. Viewpoint Old Town) development in Old Town San Diego.

I did want to reiterate previous coordination with City of San Diego, the developer, and Caltrans in the past. Attached please find Caltrans previous comment letter.

I wanted to highlight the main points of Caltrans letter below.

- The storm drain infrastructure has been moved outside Caltrans Right of Way. (Addressed in previous plans)
- Please be advised that the project may require a temporary construction permit with Caltrans.
- Caltrans' existing easement needs to remain, and be continuous along the retaining wall, and at a minimum of 10 feet wide. (Mentioned in the ADM)
- Please be advised that any proposed gates near the existing Caltrans retaining wall access, would require a Maintenance Agreement.

<u>Please coordinate with Caltrans regarding the final plans for construction to determine if a temporary construction permit will be required and if gates will be installed near the Caltrans 10-foot easement.</u>
