**Project Location:** The project is located on the west side of the Stevenson Bridge Road Bridge that crosses over Putah Creek at approximate coordinates 38.53665°N, 121.85139°W, Solano County.

**Project Description:** To authorize an overhead electrical line that crosses over Putah Creek that was installed prior to the United States Army Corps of Engineers implementing the Supplement to Standard Operation and Maintenance Manual, Sacramento River Flood Control Project, Unit No. 119 in December 1952.

**Reasons Why Project is Exempt:**

The project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15301), because the activity consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
