**PROJECT LOCATION:** Along Interstate 8 from Fairmount Avenue to the City of San Diego/City of La Mesa border on Alvarado Road west of 70th Street, San Diego County.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board is funding the Project referred to internally as Alvarado Trunk Sewer Phase IV. The Project involves replacing approximately one mile of gravity trunk sewer using open trench and trenchless methods. The Project also includes the installation of manholes, revegetation, pavement restoration, concrete replacement, signal loop replacement and curb ramp installation.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** The State Water Board has considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration as prepared by the Lead Agency. The State Water Board has approved funding for the Project described above on May 22, 2026. The City of San Diego will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the Project.

6. Findings were made pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15091.
