



CHAPTER 1 FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT: INTRODUCTION

Project Brief

This Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) describes the potential environmental effects that would result from the City of Lincoln's approval of the Lincoln Regional Airport Master Plan (State Clearinghouse Number 2007062027).

The proposed Project involves the implementation of the Lincoln Regional Airport Master Plan. The Airport Master Plan describes in detail the proposed specific projects and improvements that comprise updates to the existing airport layout plan (ALP), estimated annual aircraft operations, land uses, circulation and other infrastructure improvements.

The Master Plan identifies the updates to the existing ALP, its phasing, and the funding sources necessary to serve anticipated general aviation and other identified needs of the Lincoln Regional Airport. The Airport Master Plan includes an evaluation of historical and forecasted aircraft operations and identifies facilities and improvements necessary to meet future demands.

The Airport Master Plan developed several general planning goals for the master planning effort. These planning goals relate to various aspects of the physical layout, capacity, operations and development of Lincoln Regional Airport under development proposals considered for the master plan, including: development funding through the Federal Aviation Administration's Airport Capital Improvement Program; airport safety and reliability; adequacy of aviation-compatible commercial development; compatible land uses in currently undeveloped areas; minimizing environmental impacts and related community affects; enabling flexible airport development adaptable to changing conditions; meeting airport revenue generating goals; achieving consistency with applicable federal, state, regional and local plans; and maintaining public confidence and support.

The following is a summary of the specific airport facilities evaluated in this EIR and needed to serve projected annual aircraft operations and infrastructure needs for the year 2030:

- Extend primary runway (15R-33L) 1,000 feet to the north for a total length of 7,001 feet;
- Construct new runway safety area at north end of the extension of runway 15R-33L;
- Extend existing taxiway 1,000 feet north and construct cross taxiway and aircraft holding area to service the extension of runway 15R-33L;
- Construct a new runway (15L-33R, 3,350 feet long; 75 feet wide) parallel to existing runway (15R-33L);
- · Relocate the existing helipad;

- Construct West Side Taxiway System;
- Construct a new jet center, arrival and departure building and parking on the east side of the airport;
- Construct new hangars and aircraft parking areas south of the existing airport offices and on east side of the existing taxiway;
- Construct new roads, taxilanes, hangars and aircraft parking and infrastructure to serve the west side aviation requirements;
- Construct new access road to service the west side aviation development; and
- Construct extensions of the perimeter security fence.

Final EIR

The City prepared a Draft EIR (the Public Review Draft EIR, dated November 29, 2007) to address the potential environmental effects of the proposed Project. The DEIR was distributed through the State Clearinghouse (SCH #2007062027) for agency and public comment between November 29, 2007 and January 14, 2008. During public agency review, the California Department of Fish and Game noted that potential project impacts to the Swainson's hawk, an endangered species in California, foraging and habitat were not adequately addressed in the Biological Resources Chapter of the Draft EIR. The chaptered was recirculated for a 45 day period beginning April 12, 2008.

The DEIR distribution list and legal notices for the public review period are shown in Appendix A of this FEIR document. Public and agency comments received by the City during and after the close of the public review periods, together with the City of Lincoln's responses to these comments, are shown in Chapter 3 of this document.

The Lincoln Regional Airport Master Plan FEIR has been prepared pursuant to the requirements of CEQA and the CEQA Guidelines. Guidelines Section 15132 specifies the content of a Final EIR as:

- The Draft EIR or a revision of the draft;
- Comments and recommendations received on the Draft EIR, either verbatim or in summary;
- A list of persons, organizations, and the public agencies commenting on the Draft FIR:
- The responses of the Lead Agency to significant environmental points raised in the review and consultation process;
- Any other information added by the Lead Agency. This includes additional technical information or clarification to the Draft EIR submitted by City staff.

This FEIR includes the information necessary to meet the specified requirements of the CEQA Guidelines. Chapter 1 is this Introduction to the project background, purpose, processing history and format of the FEIR. Chapter 2 displays the summary of the DEIR. Chapter 3, a key element of the FEIR, lists all the comments received concerning the DEIR, displays the text of each comment letter, and provides the City of Lincoln's response to each of the substantive comments.

Chapter 4, titled Errata, sets forth any required revisions to the DEIR, including revisions originating with City staff. Chapter 5 includes copies of transmittal documents, the notice of availability of the DEIR for review, distribution lists for the public notices, the Notice of Completion and other records associated with the public review period for the DEIR.

The DEIR, cited below, is hereby incorporated by reference. Copies of the DEIR are available for review at the City of Lincoln, 600 Sixth Street, Lincoln CA 95648 and on the City's web site at http://www.ci.lincoln.ca.us.

EIR Certification and Findings

Sections 15090 through 15093 of the CEQA Guidelines outline procedures for decision-making by the Lead Agency (the City of Lincoln) when an EIR has been prepared. Before taking action on the project, the City must first certify that the EIR is adequate under CEQA. Then, in conjunction with their decision on the project, the City must make specific findings with respect to each of the significant environmental effects identified in the EIR, indicating whether the effect 1) will be mitigated, 2) is the responsibility of another agency, or 3) is not feasible to mitigate but is acceptable as a result of other overriding social or economic considerations.

Guidelines for the certification of an EIR (Section 15090) require that the Lead Agency certify that 1) the Final EIR has been completed in compliance with CEQA, 2) that the Final EIR was presented to the decision-making body of the Lead Agency, and that the decision-making body reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final EIR prior to approving the project, and 3) that the Final EIR reflects the Lead Agency's independent judgment and analysis.

The EIR is intended by CEQA to be an informational document (Guidelines Section 15121). Decision-making on the subject project in relation to its environmental impacts is reserved to the Lead Agency and the Responsible Agencies. Consequently, information in the EIR does not control the agency's ultimate discretion on the project, but the agency must respond to each significant effect identified in the EIR. This is accomplished through the requirement (Guidelines Section 15091) that the City decision-makers make specified findings with respect to each of the significant environmental effects identified in the EIR before they approve the project, or portions of the project. These findings are contained in a separate document that accompanies this Final EIR. The possible findings are:

- 1. Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into, the project which avoid or substantially lessen the significant environmental effect as identified in the Final EIR (i.e., the impact has been "mitigated").
- 2. Such changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of another public agency and not the agency making the finding. Such changes

have been adopted by such other agency or can and should be adopted by such other agency (i.e., mitigation is the responsibility of an agency other than the City of Lincoln).

3. Specific economic, legal, social, technological or other considerations, including provision of employment opportunities for highly trained workers, make infeasible the mitigation measures or project alternatives identified in the Final EIR (i.e., the impact is acceptable because the project's benefits outweigh it).

If the City decision-makers decide to approve the Lincoln Regional Airport Master Plan project without providing substantial mitigation for all of the significant impacts of the project (i.e. if the second or third finding options are utilized), Section 15093 allows the decision-makers to balance the project's benefits against its unavoidable environmental risks. In this case, a Statement of Overriding Considerations must be prepared and included in the project decision-making record. This project would not involve significant and unavoidable environmental impacts, and adoption of a Statement of Overriding Considerations will not be required before the project can be approved.

As a part of the project consideration and approval process described above, the City must also adopt a mitigation monitoring and/or reporting program which is fully enforceable through permit conditions, agreements, or other measures. The mitigation monitoring/reporting program for the Lincoln Regional Airport project is contained as Chapter 6 of this Final EIR.
