Project Title: Long Term Routine Maintenance Lower Campus Outflow Maintenance (Amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2011-0137-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino): The Project is located at the northeast corner of the Victor Valley Community College (VVC) campus where the Mojave River Fish Hatchery outflow passes through VVC property.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2011-0137-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Victor Valley Community College. The Agreement has been amended to include updated project description including operating an outdoor classroom, without additional impacts to CDFW resources, along with minor revisions to minimization and mitigation measures.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on April 7, 2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to Section 15096, subdivision (i) of the California Code of Regulations:

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
