## PUBLIC NOTICE

### **Big Basin Redwoods State Park Proposed General Plan Amendment and Final Environmental Impact Report**

State Parks announces today the release of the proposed Big Basin Redwoods State Park [General Plan Amendment](#) (GPA), the Final [Facilities Management Plan](#) (FMP), and [Final Environmental Impact Report](#) (EIR). Following the public review of the GPA and Draft Supplemental EIR from October 17 to December 3, 2025, the planning team prepared a Final EIR in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, including copies of all comments received and responses to these comments. No comments were received related to the Draft GPA and only formatting changes were made to the proposed GPA.

California State Parks is the lead agency for the preparation of the General Plan Amendment and associated Supplemental EIR. The decision-making body for the General Plan Amendment and Supplemental EIR is the State Park and Recreation Commission, a body of appointees that advises the Department and has final authority of approval of General Plans and certification of associated EIRs for State Parks.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that there will be a Park and Recreation Commission meeting on Thursday, July 2, 2026, which will include a hearing for consideration of the following department recommendations related to Big Basin Redwoods State Park: approval of the Draft General Plan Amendment and certification of the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (EIR).
