Project Description

The PMP Update serves as a long-range plan to establish policies and guidelines for future development within the coastal zone boundary of the Port. The PMP Update is needed to incorporate previous PMP amendments and update the existing 1990 PMP to reflect changes in the global shipping industry, technological advances, and important factors such as climate change and energy resources consistent with Green Port Policy objectives. The PMP Update is also necessary to re-evaluate land uses to ensure permitting flexibility for future development in the Port.

The Proposed Plan consists of planning area changes and potential projects. Planning area changes include a reduction in the number of planning districts from ten to seven; modifications to planning district boundaries; modifications to existing land and water uses; and addition of new land and water uses within planning districts.

Potential projects include terminal redevelopment projects and other projects that involve cuts and fills, support yards, rail and road infrastructure improvements, recreational and public access enhancements, and sediment management areas. The potential projects are in planning or conceptual stages and may be initiated by 2040. Construction of the potential projects would occur in multiple phases; however, the specific timing and in most cases, the scope of the potential projects is unknown or has not yet been developed in sufficient detail at this time.
