Project Title: Markleeville Creek Floodplain Restoration (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ALP-47551-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Markleeville Creek, in the County of Alpine, State of California; 38.694691, -119.778190 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees), and Assessor's Parcel Numbers 002-280-002-0, 002-280-003-0, 002-280-005-0, 002-280-006-0, and portions of 002-260-002-0.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number No. ALP-47551-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Alpine County Community Development as represented by Samuel Booth.

The project is limited to floodplain and streambed restoration efforts and public access facility improvements in Markleeville, California. The restoration will include reconnecting 1.4 acres of historic riparian areas and floodplains of Markleeville and Millberry Creeks by removing existing floodwalls to restore the 100-year floodplain elevation.

This is to advise that the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, acting as lead agency, has approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project.

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A mitigated negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
