**Project Title:** State Route 60/Potrero Boulevard New Interchange Project (Amendment to Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0105-R6)

**Project Location (Riverside):** Within unnamed tributaries to Cooper's Creek/San Timoteo Creek, Sections 6 and 7, Township 3S, Range 1W, north and south of State Route 60 (SR-60), east of Jackrabbit Trail, west of Interstate 10, in the City of Beaumont, County of Riverside, State of California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2017-0105-R6, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, the City of Beaumont. Phase 2 has been revised to update the Project activities to include replacement of concrete barriers on SR-60 San Timoteo Creek Bridge, without additional impacts to CDFW resources, along with minor revisions to minimization and mitigation measures.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on February 20, 2026, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were not** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
