



If applicable, describe any of the project's areas of controversy known to the Lead Agency, including issues raised by agencies and the public.

Areas of controversy include concerns expressed by San Francisco Baykeeper related to public trust resources and potential adverse impacts on tidal wetlands, rising sea levels and diminishing sediment import into the Bay. Marin Audubon Society raised concerns about estuaries between Marin County and Angel Island and related marine species and habitats. California Department of Fish and Wildlife provided input (during the SEIR scoping period) on permitting and necessary mitigation requirements to fully mitigate impacts to longfin and delta smelt (fish species).
