DOCUMENT TITLE: 1, 2, 3 TCP Removal treatment System Project (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: The Project is situated within the City of Livingston, with all pipelines and facilities to be constructed on City-owned property and within City rights-of-way in Livingston, Merced County, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board is funding the Project referred to internally as Livingston 1, 2, 3 – Trichloropropane Removal Treatment System Project. The Project includes the construction of two centralized 1,2,3-Trichloropropane (TCP) treatment plants (one at the Arakelian Park site and another at the Well No. 8 site) and approximately 6,300 feet of connecting water pipelines. At Arakelian Park, the Project includes construction of a new one million-gallon (MG) storage tank, and a 6,000 gallons per minute (gpm) booster pump station. At Well No. 8 site, a 1.5 MG storage tank and a 4,500-gpm booster pump station will be constructed.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration as prepared by the Lead Agency. The State Water Board has approved financing the Project described above on May 15, 2025. The City of Livingston will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
