Project Location (include county): The Project is located along Interstate 15 at Post Mile (PM) 26.0, within the San Bernardino National Forest Boundary in the Cajon Pass area of San Bernardino County; Latitude 34.349651, Longitude -117.446964.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SBR-24578-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation District 8. The Project will permanently impact 0.18 acres of Fish and Game Code section 1602 resources. The Project will construct a new truck scale facility on the existing southbound truck safety check area.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 3/29/2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
