Project Title: The Preserve Development - Grant Line Intersection (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-50844-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Morrison Creek, northwest of Raymer Way and Grant Line Road in the city of Rancho Cordova, California in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.575411, Longitude -121.187358 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 073-0010-012-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SAC-50844-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lennar Homes of California, Inc.

The project is limited to extending an existing culvert beneath Grant Line Road, which will be widened to improve traffic safety. The existing culvert allows an ephemeral drainage tributary to Morrison Creek to flow freely beneath the roadway. The culvert extension will match the existing culvert conditions and will consist of a 24-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe extending 8 linear feet to the west of Grant Line Road. Riprap slope protection sized appropriately for the culvert will be placed at the outlet of the culvert.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
