**Project Location:** The project is located along the landside of the new Sacramento Wier, Reclamation District 0537, Sacramento Maintenance Yard, Unit No. 01, Levee mile 0.00 to 3.22, at 38.607248°N, -121.560173°W to 38.614162°N, -121.562841°W, Sacramento River, Yolo County.

**Project Description:** Approval of Permit/Minor Alteration No. 20061, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To relocate existing overhead and underground communication lines from a temporary location to a permanent placement as part of the Sacramento Weir Widening Project. The work includes attaching approximately 1,378 linear feet of overhead communication lines to PG&E-owned poles (Board Permit No. 19662-1); attaching approximately 1,600 linear feet of communication lines on the downstream side within the deck barrier of the new Sacramento Weir bridge; and installing approximately 230 linear feet of underground communication lines at a depth of 2 feet below grade across the new County Road 126 (one 4-inch communication conduit located 12 inches from the nearest electrical conduit).

This is to advise that the Board, as the **Lead Agency**, approved the above-described project on 4/21/26 and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:
