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NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Subject: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Section 21108 of the Public Resources Code

Project Title: Crabtree Road over Dry Creek Bridge Replacement Project (Project) (Reissued California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit (ITP) No. 2081-2025-051-04)

Project Location (Stanislaus County): The Project is located approximately 5 miles north of State Route 132 and 13.6 miles east southeast of the City of Oakdale in Stanislaus County (37.711448°N, 120.609485°W).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has reissued ITP No. 2081-2025-051-04 pursuant to Section 2081(b) of the Fish and Game Code to the County of Stanislaus. The ITP is being reissued to update principal officer and contact person information.


The Project involves construction of a new bridge spanning Dry Creek and demolition of the existing bridge. The Project will result in permanent and temporary impacts to 0.54 acre and 1.6 acres, respectively, of California tiger salamander (*Ambystoma californiense*; CTS) habitat. Project activities are expected to result in incidental take of CTS which is designated as a threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as reissued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of the Project.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration **was** prepared by the lead agency for the original project.
3. Additional mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code § 21081(a). CDFW did, however, adopt findings to document its compliance with CEQA.
7. Compliance with the environmental filing fee requirement at Fish and Game Code § 711.4: **A copy of a receipt showing prior payment was submitted to CDFW.**
