**Project Location (Sonoma County):** The Project area is located within the Dry Creek Valley and would be along Dry Creek in Reach 8, in the County of Sonoma; Latitude 38.676273, Longitude -122.941684.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0116-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sonoma County Water Agency.

The project as amended includes additional maintenance activities within Reach 8.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described amendment on 7/8/2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
