Title: Issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use – Lease 6047

Location: Sovereign land in the historic bed of the San Joaquin River at Atherton Cove, adjacent to 1 Atherton Island, near Stockton, San Joaquin County.

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use beginning October 22, 2020, for a term of 10 years, for the use and maintenance of an existing boat dock, gangway, fill area, bulkhead, and bank protection previously authorized by the Commission and an existing deck not previously authorized by the Commission.

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a 10-year General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use for the above-mentioned structures will not cause a physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
