The proposed project is to construct a new 77 foot tall, V-Shaped / Full Flag / Double-Face / 14' x 48' (per sign face), LED Ready billboard on a single supporting post adjacent to and immediately west of the Interstate 710 Freeway Corridor. The subject site contains structures that operates a machine shop use, zoned (M) Manufacturing, and consists of a 91,871 (2.1 acres) property site.
