Amendment No. 2 of Streambed Alteration Agreement, Notification No. EPIMS-SDO-34398-R5, Loma Alta Slough Wetland Enhancement Project

Dear Bronti Cash:

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) received your request to amend the above referenced Streambed Alteration Agreement (Agreement) and the required fee in the amount of \$1,882.25 for a major amendment. The major amendment fee was fully paid on January 28, 2026. Your request to amend the Agreement includes changes to the Project Description and Project Impacts sections, as a result of additional encroachment needed for equipment access. This change will authorize additional temporary impacts to southern coastal salt marsh, coastal brackish marsh, saltpan/mudflats, and disturbed southern coastal salt marsh habitat types.

CDFW hereby agrees to amend the Agreement with the following amended Project Impacts (language removed is shown in ~~red with a strikethrough~~, language added is shown in **bold, italicized** text):

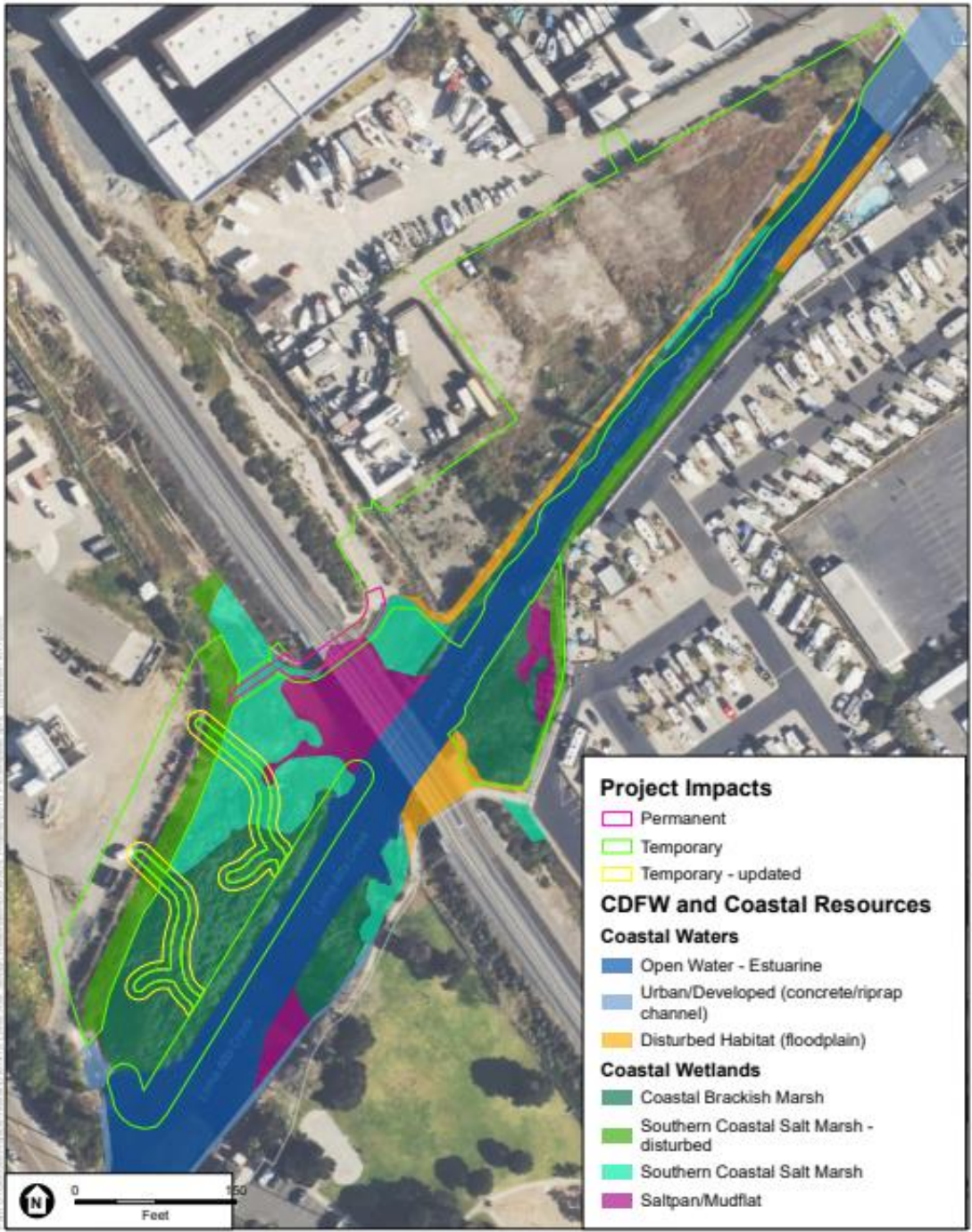

The project will temporarily impact a maximum of ~~1.10~~ **1.24** acres of existing habitats within the Stream Zone, consisting of ~~0.08~~ **0.11** acre of southern coastal salt marsh, ~~0.43~~ **0.51** acre of coastal brackish marsh, ~~0.06~~ **0.07** acre of saltpan/mudflats, 0.25 acre of open water-estuarine, 0.11 acre of disturbed habitat (floodplain), and ~~0.18~~ **0.19** acre of disturbed southern coastal salt marsh.

All other conditions in the Agreement remain in effect unless otherwise noted herein. Please sign and return one copy of this letter to acknowledge the amendment. Copies of the Agreement and this amendment must be readily available at project worksites and must be presented when requested by a CDFW representative or agency with inspection authority.


