**Project Title:** Ethanac Road Crossing of the San Jacinto River (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-RIV-40756-R6)

**Project Location (Riverside):** The Ethanac Road Crossing of the San Jacinto River Project (Project) is located at the terminus point of existing Ethanac Road and the San Jacinto River, in the City of Perris, County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33.743066° N, Longitude -117.239757° W; Sections 7, 13, and 18, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Romoland (Exhibit 1). The Project is located within Assessor's Parcel Number 330-160-007.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-RIV-40756-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, City of Perris.

The project is limited to construction of an approximately 450-foot long bridge (between abutments) crossing the San Jacinto River at Ethanac Road (Bridge) along with approximately 625 linear feet of road improvements to connect the paved portion of Ethanac Road east of the river to the proposed bridge, approximately 540 linear feet of road improvements to extend Ethanac Road from the westerly bridge abutment, and four water quality basins and storm drains to connect the water quality basins.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 6/24/2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
