PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project. Program is financing the Project referred to internally as Compliance and Sustainability Project. The Project includes installation of a new treatment facility, including a new 10' by 14' filtration building, installation of a new backwash tank, installation of a new aeration tank on a concrete slab, abandonment of existing Wells #1 and #2, installation of a replacement pump for Well #3, new pipelines for the water system, two new 45,000 gallon storage tanks on concrete slabs, a new concrete retaining wall, removal of two existing 15,000 gallon redwood water tanks and concrete pads, and installation of a permanent back-up power generator.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on December 20, 2023. The Sunrise Shore Mutual Water Company will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

- 1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
- 2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.

4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
