Project Title: Wheatland Regional Sewer Pipeline Project (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-YUB-55651-R2)

Project Location: The project is located Best Slough, Grasshopper Slough, Dry Creek, and Unnamed Tributaries, in the County of Yuba, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number EPIMS-YUB-55651-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Wheatland.

The project is limited to trenching for underground utilities and pipeline installation, underground storage tank placement, construction of a control building, grading for placement of a pump station, horizontal directional drilling, culvert replacements, jack and bore drilling, and road/trail construction.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made as a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
