Project Location (Riverside County): The Clinton Keith Marketplace Retail Project (Project) is located northwest of the intersection of Clinton Keith Road and Hidden Springs Road, in the City of Wildomar, County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude: 33.594339 Longitude: -117.248192; U.S. Geological survey 7.5-minute Murrieta quadrangle map in Section 1, Township 7 South, Range 4 West. Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-RIV-33337-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, Stephen Macie of Somar Land Group, Inc.

The Project is limited to the filling and grading of several streams identified as Drainage 1, Drainage 1.1, and Drainage 1.2. The Project will remove the existing drainages and replace them with underground storm drainpipes.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on April 15, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
