Project Title: Operation of Sebastopol Road Well - Water Supply Permit Amendment (Project)

Project Location: 5590 Sebastopol Road (Highway 12), 0.4-mile west of Llano Road

Project County: Sonoma

Project Description: The Applicant proposes to bring an existing well at Sebastopol Road Well Station into operation to increase regional drought resiliency. The well had been inactive due to inadequate disinfection. The Applicant installed 250 feet of 36" diameter piping to reconnect the well to the existing system and added four-Log Virus Treatment to meet potable water use requirements.

Public Agency Approving the Project: State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board)

This is to advise that the State Water Board has issued a domestic water supply permit amendment for the above-described Project on February 26, 2026. A record of permit approval for the Project is available to the public at the State Water Board, Division of Drinking Water district office listed above.
