Project Title: Regional General Permit 53 for Roads and Flood Control Maintenance (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SDO-62666-R5)

Project Location: San Diego County

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SDO-62666-R5), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, County of San Diego, Department of Public Works. The project proposes to perform routine flood control maintenance activities for bridges, culverts, and selected channels to prevent flooding of adjacent roadways, residential and commercial properties, and other public infrastructure. The project is located within 894 facilities (bridges, culverts, and selected channels) related to County-maintained roads and flood control facilities in various streams throughout San Diego County.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 4/22/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
