Title: Amendment of General Lease – Public Agency Use

Applicant: City of Del Mar

Location: Sovereign land in the San Dieguito River, near Del Mar, San Diego County

Description: The existing Camino Del Mar bridge (Bridge No. 57C-0209) will be replaced to provide continued vehicle, pedestrian, and bicycle movement along Camino Del Mar as it crosses the San Dieguito Lagoon. The slightly higher, longer, and wider bridge will maintain critical north-south access and improve public safety in consideration of potential flooding, sea level rise, and other hazard conditions. The State Lands Commission action is amendment of a 49-year General Lease – Public Agency Use.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 9, 2026, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for this project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the City of Del Mar (City), adopted the MND and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) and approved the project on

April 3, 2023. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by the City and adopted the MMRP. The MND and the record of project approval may be examined at the California State Lands Commission office address.
