PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project's purpose is to demolish and remove surface and subsurface facilities and subsequent remediation of impacted soils at the onshore Carpinteria Oil and Gas Processing Facility.

CDPR would grant a right of entry permit to Chevron U.S.A. for temporary access to State Park property to stage equipment and access a portion of beach directly to the east of Carpinteria State Beach. The project would be subject to mitigation measures prepared within the EIR as well as additional measures provided by CDPR to ensure the protection of the resources of Carpinteria SB.

CDPR (the Responsible Agency) independently considered the EIR certified by the City of Carpinteria (the Lead Agency).

This is to advise that the California Department of Parks and Recreation has reviewed the above project and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDPR's purview as a Responsible Agency.
- 2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project by the City of Carpinteria as the lead agency pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
 A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project, pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3. Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4. A Mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was was not adopted for this project.
- 5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for this project.
- 6. Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
