PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Zone Reclassification of a 4.96-acre parcel from AG-40 (General Agriculture, 40-acre minimum) to I-W (Warehouse). The underlying project, a Site Approval for truck parking, is submitted concurrently. The project proposes a 4,900-square-foot shop, to include a restroom and breakroom, and parking for 96 semi-trailer trucks. (Use Type: Truck Sales & Services – Parking)

The Property is zoned AG-40 (General Agriculture, 40-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is I/L (Limited Industrial).

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The project site is located on the east side of N. Thornton Rd.; 1,300 feet north of State Route 12, Lodi. (APN/Address: 025-190-31 / 15314 N. Thornton Rd., Lodi) (Supervisorial District: 4)
