Project Title: Erickson Residence (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-NAP-51224-R3)

Project Location (Napa County): The Project is located at one culverted section of unnamed tributary to Hirsch Creek (Culvert D, one section of un-culverted tributary to Hirsch Creek (Realigned Stream Channel A) and an invasive species removal area (Invasive Species Removal Area), in an unincorporated area of the Napa County approximately 1.2 miles west of the town of St. Helena, State of California.

- Culvert D: 38.522961°N, -122.512949°W
- Realigned Stream Channel A: 38.525275°N, -122.512247°W
- Invasive Species Removal Area: 38.5238°N, -122.51257°W

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-NAP-51224-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the Project Applicant, Osborn Erickson.

The Project is limited to one culvert replacement (Culvert D), temporary disturbance of one section of stream (Realigned Stream Channel A), and invasive plant removal activities (Invasive Species Removal Area) to offset unauthorized culvert replacement work completed in 2022. No tree removal will result from Project activities.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on May 21, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
