The relocation would require approval of a Conditional Use Permit to develop a comprehensive administrative, bus storage, and bus maintenance facility at the proposed Project Site. The Proposed Project would include an 11,470-square-foot (SF) maintenance, building and an 11,200-SF administrative building. The maintenance facility would consist of service bays, a bus wash, and other support spaces for drivers and MT's bus fleet. The proposed administration/operations building would house administrative offices and support spaces for staff.
