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## NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

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**Subject:** Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Section 21108 of the Public Resources Code

**State Clearinghouse Number:** 2023050534

**Project Title:** Fenton Parkway Bridge Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SDO-55913-R5)

**Project Location (San Diego County):** Northeast Mission Valley community of the City of San Diego, San Diego County, south of Fenton Parkway and north of Camino Del Rio North.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SDO-55913-R5, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to San Diego State University. The Project includes construction of the Fenton Parkway Bridge Project to connect Fenton Parkway, which currently terminates north of the San Diego River channel, with Camino Del Rio North, south of the river channel. The bridge will be approximately 450 feet long and 58 feet wide, supported on concrete seat-type abutments at each end and 3 piers within the channel. Each of the abutments would be protected with energy-dissipating riprap that would be buried to allow for post-construction habitat restoration over the riprap.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 3/2/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to Section 15096, subdivision (i) of the California Code of Regulations:
