## **Project Location**

Southwest corner of the intersection of Taft Highway (SR 119) and Stine Road in the City of Bakersfield, California. The site is within Section 3, Township 31 South, Range 27 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Access to the site will be from Stine Road.

## **Project Description**

The Panama-Buena Vista Union School District (District), as Lead Agency, is proposing a new elementary school on a 20-acre undeveloped site (APN 184-220-09).

The new elementary school campus will be approximately 101,000 square feet which will include classrooms, administration offices, parking, and play areas. The new school will serve the surrounding community and will serve approximately 1,200 students and 80 teachers at full build-out. Solar panels may be installed on building rooftops and/or used to create covered parking for staff and visitors. The hours of operation are expected to be between 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
