Project Location: The Project is located at 4055 Prussian Hill Road, Unincorporated CA 95248 in Calaveras County.

## **Project Description:**

The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Procession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a Cannabis Cultivation License. Operations for the proposed project will involve outdoor cannabis cultivation within twenty-five (25) hoop houses, including two (2) immature plant hoop houses. No artificial lighting will be used. Natural light with light deprivation will be used. Processing and packaging of the cannabis will take place in two (2) steel, 8' x 12' cargo containers. The operation will employ between 8 and 15 individuals per month, with variable hours as operations require.

## **Project Activities:**

The Project will consist of cannabis plants grown in hoop houses, in raised beds atop an impervious lining where they will be watered via measured drip irrigation. Light deprivation with no artificial lighting will be used, and no measurable amounts of wastewater will be generated. Two (2) 8' x 12' steel cargo containers will be used as processing and packaging buildings. Two (2) hoop houses will be seasonally used as drying huts. Operations for the proposed project will involve outdoor cannabis cultivation within twenty-five (25) hoop houses, including two (2) immature plant hoop houses. No artificial lighting will be used. Natural light with light deprivation will be used. Processing and packaging of the cannabis will take place in two (2) steel, 8' x 12' cargo containers. The operation will employ between 8 and 15 individuals per month, with variable hours as operations require. Project operations are anticipated to generate the following traffic: 3-4 employee work trips per day; 1 trip for material and supplies delivery per day; and 5 to 6 trips per week for transportation of finished product, seasonally (three times per year). Well water is available to for irrigation and fire protection purposes. Solid waste will be either composted on site or transported to a licensed landfill. An approved portable toilet, with a handwashing station, will be placed on the site.
