Project Location: The Project is located on Sutter Creek, a tributary to Dry Creek, in the County of Amador, State of California; The work spans Latitude 38.355311, Longitude – 120.932575 to Latitude 38.353660, Longitude -120.958535; Section 25/26, Township 06N, Range 09E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map lone, Mount Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement Extension EPIMS Notification Number AMA-13940 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Lone as represented by Janice Traverso.

The project is limited to the clearing of vegetation along the banks and channel of a 2.5-mile stretch of Sutter Creek and the removal, via excavation, of 50,000 cubic yards of excess sediment from the bed of a 0.5-mile stretch of Sutter Creek.
