Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project would construct tertiary treatment facilities within the existing WRP 4 plant site to enable production of up to 10 million gallons per day (MGD) of non-potable recycled water for irrigation. CVWD has developed three phases to achieve 10 MGD production and distribution: Phase 1 would produce 1 MGD, Phase 2 would produce an additional 1.5 MGD for a total of 2.5 MGD, and Phase 3 would produce up to 10 MGD.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The proposed project may have potentially significant effects to Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Noise, Transportation, and Tribal Cultural Resources. Mitigation measures are proposed to reduce impacts:

AQ-1: Valley Fever.

BIO-1: Nesting Birds, BIO-2: Burrowing Owl, BIO-3: Nighttime Lighting, BIO-4: General Avoidance and Minimization Measures, and BIO-5: Bats.

CUL-1: Cultural Resources Sensitivity Training, CUL-2: Unanticipated Find Protocol, CUL-3: Treatment Plan Development, CUL-4: Final Monitoring Report, and CUL-5: Human Remains.

NOISE-1: Construction Noise.

TRA-1: Traffic Control Plan.

TCR-1: Native American Monitor.

During the NOP public review period, concerns were raised regarding potential impacts to the Salton Sea and surrounding areas from reduced discharge of the project on biology, air quality/greenhouse gas emissions, public health, and water quality.
