The proposed project includes 29,459 square feet of improvements to the project site including: classroom building 'G' consisting of two classrooms, staff restroom, student restrooms, a janitor room, workroom, and vestibule totaling 3,445 square feet;3,980 square foot kindergarten play area; accessible parking lot with a total of 13 new parking spaces and bicycle parking; ingress and egress at the new parking lot; paved walkway connecting the existing campus to the new classroom; and chain link fencing, landscape improvements, and stormwater retention basin. Total school enrollment capacity will not be increased

by the project.
