Project Title: EA 03-1J630_SR 99 PM 6.07 & 7.06 Willow Slough Bridge Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-49817-R2) Amendment

Project Location: The project is located at Willow Slough on State Route 99 between post mile (PM) 6.04 and PM 7.06 in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.332371, Longitude -121.330700 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to the Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SAC-49817-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation, as represented by Katlin Ly-Lee.

The amendment increases project impacts by permanently removing an additional 0.02 acres of riparian habitat. A valley oak tree measured 12-inch diameter at breast height will be removed. Compensatory mitigation will be increased from 0.52 acres to 0.60 acres of created or restored riparian habitat. Project applicant will also be updated.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Amendment on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The negative declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the above Streambed Alteration Agreement Amendment as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
