Project Title: Wolf Reservoir and Booster Replacement Project-Water Supply Permit Amendment (Project)

Project Applicant: Big Bear Lake Department of Water and Power

Project Location: Northeast corner of the intersection of Wolf Road and Coyote Court, 34°14'00.8"N 116°50'51.9"W, Big Bear Lake, San Bernardino County

Project Description: The Applicant proposes to operate a new 612,000-gallon water storage reservoir tank that replaces the old 100,000-gallon Wolf Reservoir.

This is to advise that the State Water Resources Control Board (Responsible Agency) has approved the above-described Project on April 15, 2026, and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the State Water Board's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
