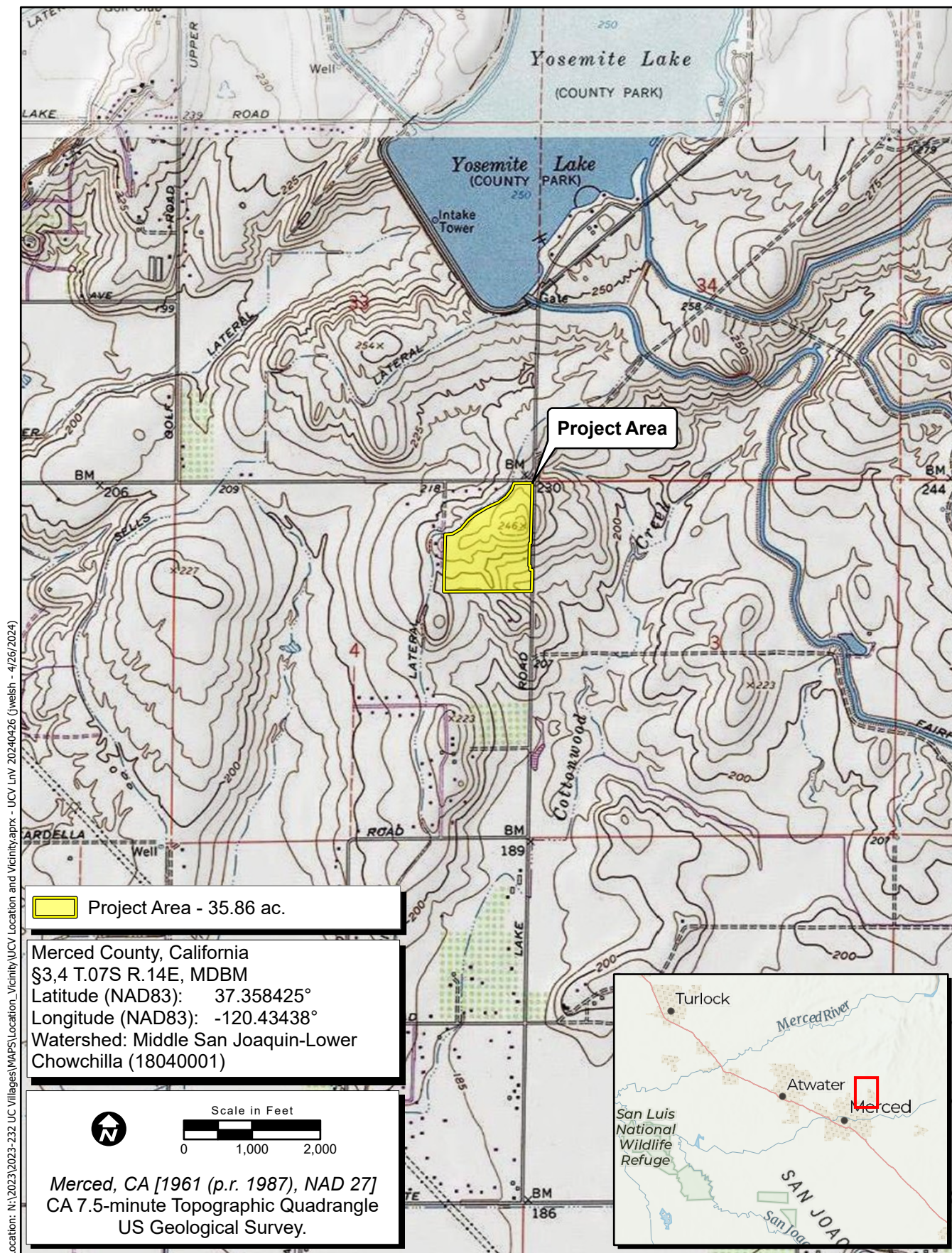


Figure 1. Project Location and Vicinity
