DOCUMENT TITLE: Greenfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvement Project (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: Walnut Avenue and Espinosa Road. City of Greenfield and unincorporated Monterey County, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is funding the Project referred to internally as Greenfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvement Project. The Project includes the construction of a new wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) facility, and the subsequent demolition of the existing WWTP. Potable and recycled water pipelines will be constructed within the right-of-way of Walnut Avenue west towards Thorp Avenue. The Project also includes construction of a recycled water pipeline in the access road between the WWTP and effluent disposal site, and construction of a recycled water pump station on the existing effluent disposal site.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration as prepared by the Lead Agency. The State Water Board has approved funding for the Project described above on April 28, 2026. The City of Greenfield will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the Project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines.
