Project Title: 1L150 I-15 CAPM Pavement Rehabilitation and Culvert Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SBR-62110-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino): The 1L150 I-15 CAPM Pavement Rehabilitation and Culvert Repairs Project (Project) is located on Interstate 15 (I-15) near Baker, north of Basin Road and south of Halloran Springs Road, between Post Mile (PM) 122.23 and 142.97, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California. T

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SBR-62110-R6, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation, District 8.

The Project is limited to the modification of seven drainage systems and streambeds along the I-15, involving the relining of existing culverts and at location 6, the installation of 900 sq. feet of rock slope protection.


This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on May 8, 2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
