Project Title: EA 03-0J410_Alta I-80 CAPM PM 33.0 – 44.9 (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-57271-R2) Amendment

Project Location: The project is located at multiple unnamed tributaries to Canyon Creek and Bear River between post mile (PM) 33.0 and 44.9 along Interstate 80 (I-80), in the County of Placer, State of California; U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) maps Dutch Flat and Chicago Park.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to the Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-57271-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation, as represented by Sean Shaw.

This amendment includes changes in scope of work for multiple culvert work locations, including but not limited to, the replacement and/or installation of drainage inlets, rock slope placement, flared end sections, and culverts; addition of a work period modification measure; and update to the project plans. Temporary impacts to bed, bank, and channel habitat will be increased from 0.15 acres to 0.154 acres.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement Amendment on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.

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4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
