To reduce significant direct impacts to sensitive species and sensitive vegetation community, the implementation of Mitigation Measure BIO 1, BIO-2, BIO-3 and BIO-4 would be required prior to approval of any plan or issuance of any permit, and prior to use of the premises in reliance of this permit. With implementation of Mitigation Measure BIO-1, BIO-2, BIO-3 and BIO-4, impacts to sensitive plant and vegetation communities would be less than significant.

Based on an analysis of County of San Diego archaeology resource files, archaeological records, maps, and aerial photographs by County of San Diego senior adjunct archaeologist, it has been determined that the project site does not contain any archaeological resources; however, resources are present in the surrounding area. As such, subsurface, unidentified resources may be present. Therefore, a Treatment Agreement and Preservation Plan, and an archaeological and tribal monitoring program will be required. Implementation of Mitigation Measure CUL-1 would reduce impacts to less than significant.
