Title: Butte Slough Outfall Gates Repair Project

Applicant: California Department of Water Resources

Location: Sovereign land in Butte Slough and the Sacramento River, adjacent to 2701 Butte Slough Road, near Colusa, Sutter and Colusa Counties

Description: The Department of Water Resources (DWR) Division of Flood Management proposes several maintenance repairs to the Butte Slough Outfall Gates including a new inlet slide gate, installing a new facility control building and installing water flow/condition monitoring equipment. The State Lands Commission action is approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through February 8, 2046.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 9, 2026, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for this project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, DWR, adopted the MND and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) and approved the project on February 20, 2025. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this

project by DWR and adopted the MMRP. The MND, MMRP, and the record of project approval may be examined at the California State Lands Commission office address.
