Project Title: Greenwood Beach Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MAN-56081-R3)

Project Location (Marin County): The proposed project site is located along an unnamed flood control channel the drains from Ring Mountain and enters Greenwood and Brunini Beaches on the Shoreline of Richardson Bay (near Blackie's Pasture).


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-MAN-56081-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, David Eshoo/Town of Tiburon.

The purpose of the project is to restore and enhance Greenwood and Brunini Beaches using nature-based, living shoreline solutions to reduce rates of shoreline erosion, improve shoreline habitat and recreational values, and improve shoreline sea level rise resilience. The project activities subject to the Streambed Alteration Agreement are limited to placement of cobble armored salt marsh along the top of the west bank of the unnamed flood control channel at its confluence with Richardson Bay and construction of a low-flow bypass channel to ensure estuarine fish movement between the flood control channel and the tidal flats of Richardson Bay.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 4/16/2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
