WAVERLY ROAD RESURFACING

Project Description

Project Location:

Waverly Road: 9,320 feet south of Shelton Road to Shelton Road. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

Waverly Road is a rural local road that was originally paved in 1965 with 0.18 feet of asphalt concrete over 0.25 feet of aggregate base (AB). The road was resurfaced in 1981 with 0.25 feet of asphalt concrete (AC). The original construction included asphalt concrete dikes a single 48-inch culvert minor structure and a dual 60-inch culvert minor structure. The rural road has been maintained by periodic chip seals and was last treated in 2018.

There is moderate alligator cracking, block cracking, and transverse cracking along the length of the roadway, with major rutting, patches of bleeding, roadway spalling, and weathering throughout the project limits.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Resurfacing existing 24-foot-wide roadway with 0.25-foot Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A).
2. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.50' HMA.
3. Paving Driveways (Type D and E).
4. Placing penetration treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' in each direction or to conform.
5. Removing and replacing AC dikes.
6. Replenishing 4-foot-wide shoulder backing as needed: 2' (8%) and 2' to conform.
7. Performing earthwork at areas with high shoulders.

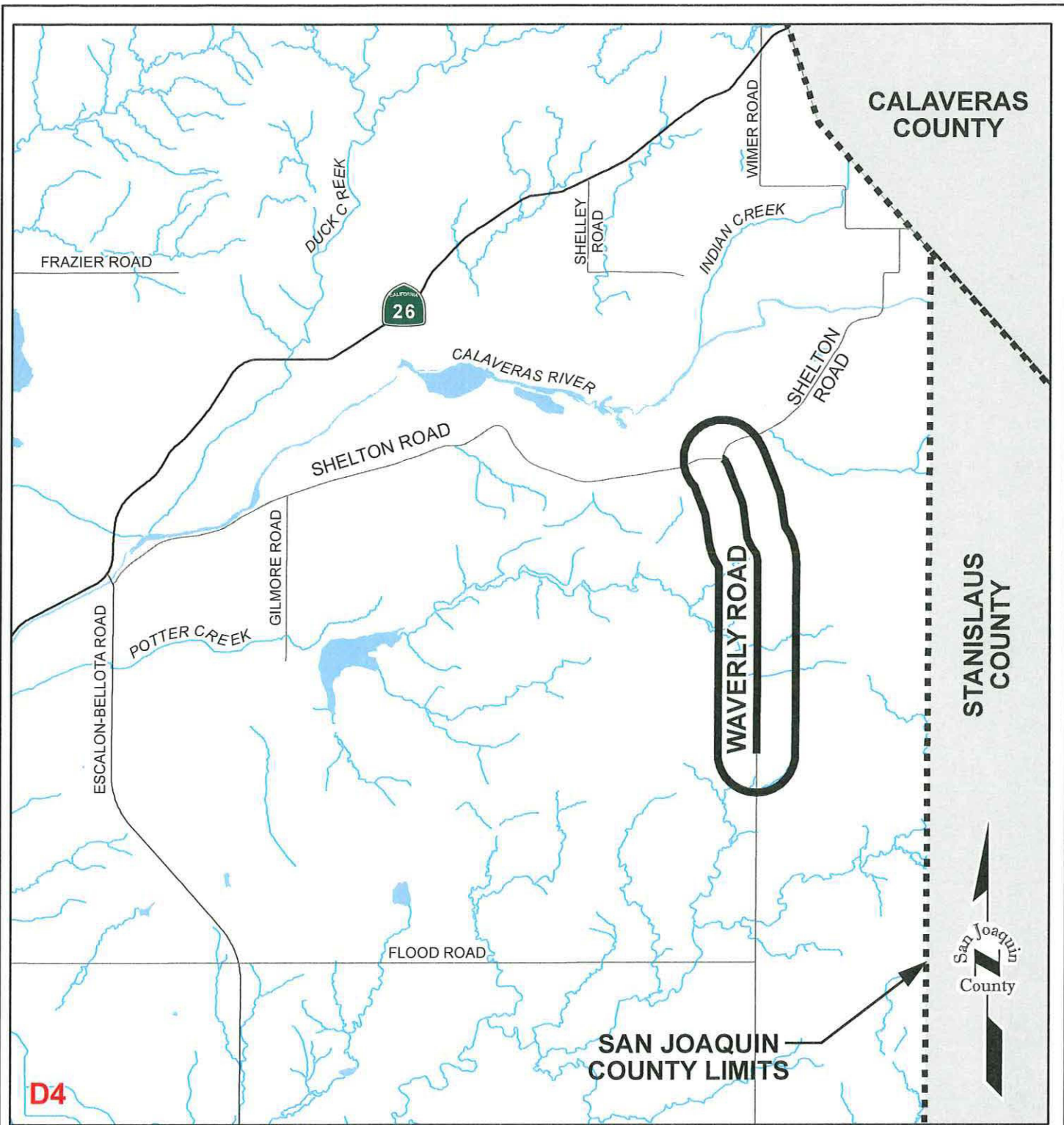
Environmental Setting:

In this portion of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes**.

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

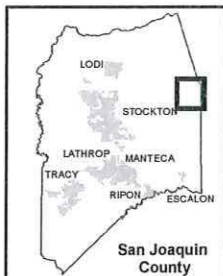
The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
