Pump Station H Rehabilitation Phase 2 (SD-444)

Overview and Background

The East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) Pump Station H is a critical facility that serves the South Interceptor System. Flow cannot be bypassed with current equipment and configuration requiring Pump Station H to temporarily be out of service in emergency scenarios. The Pump Station H Rehabilitation Phase 2 (Project) includes the replacement of aging mechanical equipment and resurfacing concrete surfaces. The improvements address the lack of redundancy and allows for continuous operations during emergency scenarios or construction.

Project Purpose and Objectives

This project will perform work on EBMUD's wastewater facility, Pump Station H. This project will strengthen existing structures and replace aging equipment in order to support operational needs.

Project Location

The Project is located in the City of Oakland near High Street and Oakport Street. All work will be completed within the existing wastewater facility on EBMUD property. Refer to Figure 1 for the project location.

Project Characteristics

The scope of work includes the following improvements at the wastewater facility:

- Replace existing equipment
- Resurface concrete

Permits and Approvals

No permits are required for the Project because all work will be performed on EBMUD's property and the Project scope of work is limited to repair, replacement, and/or minor alteration to an existing wastewater facility.

Public Considerations

The Project is within EBMUD's property and adjacent to public access routes in the City of Oakland within 30 ft of commercial areas.

Schedule and Work Hours

Construction is scheduled to begin in February 2025. The estimated construction duration is approximately 21 months. Regular construction work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction also involves 24/7 work from June 2025 through September 2025.
